

- All MTD buses will operate on **SUNDAY schedules on Monday**, July 4th.
- **DURING THE PARADE:** Routes 1, 2, 6, 11, 14, and 20 will be detoured between approximately 12pm and 3pm for the parade on State Street. MTD will shuttle passengers who need to make connections between the Transit Center and the Library on Anacapa Street. Passengers should allow extra time to reach their destinations during this time.
- **THE DOWNTOWN SHUTTLE** will provide service approximately every 10 minutes between the Dolphin Fountain and Sola Street, but there will be a break in service from about 12pm 3pm for the parade and the shuttles will be on a detour route during the Heritage Expo after the parade. When lower State Street is closed to traffic, the shuttles will turn around via Gutierrez, Chapala, & Haley Streets. They will not serve the Dolphin Fountain after that time.
- WATERFRONT SHUTTLE service will be provided between the Harbor and the Zoo approximately every 15 minutes from 10am to 6pm, or as long as Cabrillo Boulevard remains open to traffic.
- AFTER THE FIREWORKS on July 4th, buses will depart MTD's downtown Transit Center (1020 Chapala Street) as follows:
