

System Ridership Report: March 2014

System-wide ridership decreased 2% for the month compared to March 2013. Three-quarters of the overall decline in ridership for March is in the SBCC-student category, particularly on Lines 2, 20, and 17. Year-to-date, SBCC ridership declines account for 41% of the overall decrease. UCSB ridership has also decreased, but less significantly. Counterbalancing the student ridership declines somewhat, the passengers from five cruise ships helped boost shuttle ridership in March (there were no cruise ship visits in March 2013). Since many of the cruise-ship passengers are senior citizens, the ridership increase shows up in the "Senior" category in Table A, below.

External Factors Affecting Ridership

Service Days & School Days: There was the same number of weekday, Saturday, and Sunday service days in March 2014 as in March 2013. Each of the schools was in session the same number of days as well.

Weather: Temperatures for March 2014 were a bit warmer than in 2013 and about 4° warmer than normal for the month overall. The rain that arrived at the end of February lingered into the first couple of days of March, leaving almost an inch of precipitation behind. Bookending the month, a little bit more rain fell on the 31st.

Addendum: Data Source Documentation

GFI Genfare data is taken directly from the electronic farebox system on each MTD vehicle so equipped. In general, GFI data has not been verified, modified, adjusted, added, or removed since being captured at the time of the driver/passenger transaction. GFI data is considered raw data.

Passdat program accuracy is determined by the amount of GFI farebox data that remains unchanged as compared to Trapeze Run and Trip templates for the evaluation time period. Both human and mechanical errors influence the need to make manual adjustments. These corrections are defined and determined by evaluation of historical and experiential ridership patterns.
